CHAMPAGNE WHITE - FRANCE

CHAMPAGNE DEUTZ BRUT CLASSIC

Glera grapes – Le Contesse, Veneto

(Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier)
Champagne Deutz, located in Ay (Marne), was founded in 1838 by German-born William Deutz and P.H. Geldermann. Owned by the Lallier family since 1906, their hallmark is the "Brut Classic" which is produced annually with consistent quality. Robert Parker consistently awards it 90+ points. This cuvée's golden robe reveals a graceful ballet of fine bubbles. Expressive floral aromas are supported by notes of toast, marzipan and ripe fruit. Its silky texture balances the freshness of Chardonnay, the fruit of Pinot Noir, and the vinous character of Pinot Meunier.

The Donatsch winery in the picturesque village of Malans has been family-owned for over 120 years. Thomas Donatsch, the fourth generation, is considered a revolutionary in Swiss winemaking and recognized by Gault&Millau as a national wine icon. In the early 1970s, he began aging Pinot Noir and Chardonnay in French barriques, following Burgundian traditions. Since 2001, his son Martin has led the winery with the same experimental and quality-driven mindset. Martin believes Graubünden ranks among the best Pinot Noir regions globally. Donatsch wines are now fixtures on the wine lists of Switzerland's finest restaurants.

In 2005, Michele Conceprio partnered with Adriano Kaufmann and eventually took over his vineyards and winery in Terre del Malcantone. In 2014, he made a pivotal decision to convert all vineyards to organic farming. His aim was to eliminate synthetic chemicals and restore balance between soil, vine, and climate. "Pio" symbolizes reverence for the terroir. Grapes are hand-picked, gently pressed, and fermented in large oak barrels. The wine then matures in French oak for about 14 months.

Maison Jaboulet Aîné was founded in 1834 by Antoine Jaboulet in Tain l'Hermitage with a mission to produce great wines. Over six generations, the family acquired some of the finest vineyards in the Rhône Valley, including 26 hectares in top Hermitage AOC locations. In 2006, the estate was bought by the Frey family, also known for wine production in Bordeaux and Champagne. Major investments were made in quality and sustainability. Today, many wines from organic or biodynamic farming are certified.

RIBERA DEL DUERO

Carmelo Rodero's grandparents already cultivated vines in the traditional way in Pedrosa de Duero, a small wine-growing community in the province of Burgos, north of the Duero River in Spain. Though not predestined, Carmelo was drawn to viticulture. By investing early earnings into new plots, he and his wife Elena now own 140 hectares of high-altitude land (750–900m), characterized by pronounced daily temperature shifts—ideal for wine quality.

Hacienda Monasterio is located in the province of Valladolid, in Castile and León. Its vineyards are positioned between Pesquera and Valbuena de Duero in the Ribera del Duero region, a 20,000-hectare appellation known for premium red wines. In the late 20th century, the estate was taken over by French architect Philippe Mazières, who had worked at prestigious estates such as Château Margaux. Today, oenologist Peter Sisseck and winemaker Carlos de la Fuente lead the winery.
